[4-3. ASNMSU SENATE REMOVAL AND IMPEACHMENT ACT

4-3-1. MAIN PROVISION

Any ASNMSU Senator shall be removed from office if the Senator is referred to the Supreme Court by a three-quarters (3/4) vote of the membership of the ASNMSU Senate present and voting or if the Senator is referred to the Supreme Court by their college council upon the accumulation of penalty points as mentioned in Sections 8-9-K-3 and 8-9-K-4 of the Rules of the Senate, and the Senator is found guilty of the charges made against the Senator by the ASNMSU Supreme Court.

4-3-2. PROCEDURE

A. Before the ASNMSU Senate can refer a Senator to the Supreme Court for impeachment proceedings, a resolution must be introduced into the Senate. This resolution will include the specific reasons for referral. After the introduction of the resolution, the Chief Senate Clerk will notify, in writing within two (2) days, the Senator of any meeting where the Senator's position is being officially discussed. The Senator who is charged will be allowed to speak at any meeting where the Senator's position is being officially discussed. No referral resolution will be allowed to go through Committee of the Whole.

B. Before the Supreme Court can consider the impeachment of any ASNMSU Senator, the ASNMSU Chief Justice of the Supreme Court will make an attempt to notify, in writing within two (2) days of the receipt of the resolution, the person who is to be impeached and the charges against this person. The person, who is charged, will be allowed to speak at any meeting where the person's position is being officially discussed.

C. Any ASNMSU Senator will be impeached upon a majority vote of the Supreme Court.]
