



58 Subsection A: Jordan Bengé, Grace McMurry, Rembrandt Fernandez, Luisa Bannister, Jonathan Luna, Carson
59 Casey, Tomas Herrera, Adrianna Erives Gonzalez, Karen Estrada, Simon Valdez, and Victoria Hart competed
60 against the 25 best schools in the nation for the best concrete canoe. They designed and molded a concrete canoe,
61 wrote a design paper, and gave an oral presentation which were all judged to contribute to their overall score.

63 Subsection B: The students competing at the ASCE National Concrete Canoe Competition required waterproof
64 materials, seeing it necessary as the canoe would need to be waterproof to be effective against its competitors.
